We believe it will substantially increase the overall club security. Cards will be only issued to wet berth members having boats at the yacht club.

We are going to operate our Stephens Islands Squataree facility again this year. I think we have got some of the ' kinks' out of the system and Brian Bosman will have his crew out there to manage the day to day business of the club. The yacht club executive is still working hard to secure additional funds through the WCAPP programs to improve our docks and piling systems there. We are hopeful that we will be successful with our application and get the work completed in the spring of 2011.
